PACE will improve student academic success.

Objective: Increase student retention by 5% annually.

Current: 21/22 retention 46% as of 11/6/21. PACE student retention has been approximately 71% annually for the last 6 years. The percentage of students reenrolling by 5/31 /21 was 31.59%. The 5-year average of students reenrolling by 5/31 is 22%.

Objective: Ensure 100% of POW homeschool students are aware of dual enrollment opportunities with CES, CMS, and CHS and maintain dual enrollment of POW students at 35%.

Current: Craig/Klawock D-E for 21/22 is 34% as of 11/6/21. In Craig/Klawock current dual enrollment for 20/21 was 27.91% (12 out of 43 students) Currently 35 POW students.

Objective: Increase student 4-year cohort graduation rate to 100%.

Current: The 20/21 rate was 25%. The 19/20 30.77%. The 18/19 22.22% The 17/18 18.75%.

PACE will provide parents with a greater knowledge to educate children.

Objective: Build relationships by increasing family communication to 100%.

Current: October 2021 monthly contacts was 98% with 4% marked as atttempts.

Objective: Increase teacher knowledge of curricular options.

Current: The Curriculum Browser has been updated but does not have parent recommendation. Teachers have been meeting monthly with new curricula ideas and review of current less used curriculum.

Objective: 90% of PACE families are proactive and self-sufficient with work samples, quarterly grades, and Purchase Requests by 2023. Submitting work samples on or before the due date.
